Storage:	Store at 4°C short term. Aliquot and store at -20°C for 12 months. Avoid freeze/thaw cycles.
Background:	Lactate dehydrogenase (LDH) catalyzes the interconversion of pyruvate and NADH to lactate and NAD ⁺ . When the oxygen supply is too low for mitochondrial ATP production, this reaction recycles NADH generated in glycolysis to NAD ⁺ , which reenters glycolysis. The major form of LDH found in muscle cells is the A (LDHA) isozyme.
